## **SUGGESTED OUTFIT LIST**

There is no required uniform. Below is a list of suggested items to be brought to camp for a 25-day session. Please adjust according to length of stay. Laundry is sent out in the middle of each 13-day session. It is returned the next day. A GOOD CAMPER TRAVELS LIGHT.

1 duffel bag 1 box Kleenex 1 lightweight sleeping bag 1 bathrobe

1 canoe trip pack 1 laundry bag with your name clearly marked

(large enough to hold sleeping 3 towels

bag and change of clothing) puff for bathing 1 government-approved life-jacket for paddling in 2 blankets, single size puff for bathing 1 comb and brush

2 sheets, single size 1 or 2 toothbrushes and toothpaste

1 small pillow sunscreen for canoe trips 2 pillow cases paper & envelopes

1 jacket 1 flashlight
2 sweaters 2 sets batteries
1 hat pens and pencils

2 pairs sneakers 2 yards colourful fabric to decorate stand beside bed

1 pair hiking boots deodorant

1 raincoat thumb tacks, rope, clothes-pins

3 pairs jeans or pants tampons or sanitary pads [BIODEGRADABLE]

2 pair pyjamas (1 warm) sunglasses [UV protective]

2 bathing suits insect repellent

3 pairs shorts water bottle

6 shirts or turtlenecks; mix of long & short sleeves <u>EXTRAS</u> 6 pairs socks, some wool fishing tackle

10 sets underwear 1 bottle of **BIODEGRADABLE** cold water soap (Woolite)

disposable or inexpensive digital camera; (if would like to hand-wash clothing)

cell phones may not be used as cameras
1 soap\* [BIODEGRADABLE] and container
shampoo\* [BIODEGRADABLE] watch or clock (not expensive)
musical instrument, books
dry bag for canoe tripping

<u>NOTES:</u> Please do not bring trunks or foot-lockers to camp as a large wooden chest is provided for each camper. iPods, jewelry, cell phones and valuables must be left at home. If your daughter wears glasses it is a good idea to send along an extra pair. As canoe tripping is one of our major activities some old clothes ("trip clothes") are advisable. All items are to fit into the Duffel Bag and Trip Pack.

At Camp Birthday (August 18th) first generation campers wear navy blue shirts, second generation red shirts, third green, and fourth yellow, along with white or light coloured shorts or slacks.

## ALL ARTICLES MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH CAMPER'S NAME

PASSPORTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CAMPERS FLYING TO AND FROM CANADA. PASSPORTS ARE ALSO REQUIRED FOR LAND BORDER CROSSINGS INTO THE UNITED STATES.
