[\$80.00 for a 13 day session Ages 7-12, \$120.00 for a 13 day session Ages 13-16] • [\$160.00 for a 25 day session Ages 7-12, \$240.00 for a 25 day session Ages 13-16] •
[\$320.00 for a 50 day session Ages 7-12, \$400.00 for a 50 day session Ages 13-16] to cover canoe trip permits, laundry, stamps and incidental necessities.

There is a 10% reduction for 2nd and 3rd children of the same family who attend Northway or Wendigo during the same session. There is also a 10% reduction for Counselors-in-Training attending the 7 week session. A 13% Sales Tax is added to the tuition, store deposit and bus fee.

Northway's Electronics Policy:

Cell phones, iPods, etc. are not allowed at Northway. They can greatly detract from the wilderness experience. Camp is an opportunity for your daughter to have a break from all the technology that is ever-present in her life throughout the rest of the year. As a child's dependence on electronic entertainment and communication increases, so does the importance of time away from it. Camp is an opportunity for your daughter to grow and experience greater independence and autonomy. She will form friendships with other girls that will last a lifetime. Keeping the camp environment free of distracting electronic devices will help this special bonding experience. A child who brings electronics to camp can unwittingly ruin the wilderness experience for her fellow campers. Thank you for your understanding and support of this policy.

shampoo* [BIODEGRADABLE]	dry bag for canoe tripping

*Biodegradable soap such as CampSuds or Dr. Bronners, which can be used for hair and body.

NOTES: Please do not bring trunks or foot-lockers to camp as a large wooden chest is provided for each camper. iPods, jewelry, cell phones and valuables must be left at home. If your daughter wears glasses it is a good idea to send along an extra pair. As canoe tripping is one of our major activities some old clothes ("trip clothes") are advisable. All items are to fit into the Duffel Bag and Trip Pack.

At Camp Birthday (August 18th) first generation campers wear navy blue shirts, second generation red shirts, third green, and fourth yellow, along with white or light coloured shorts or slacks.

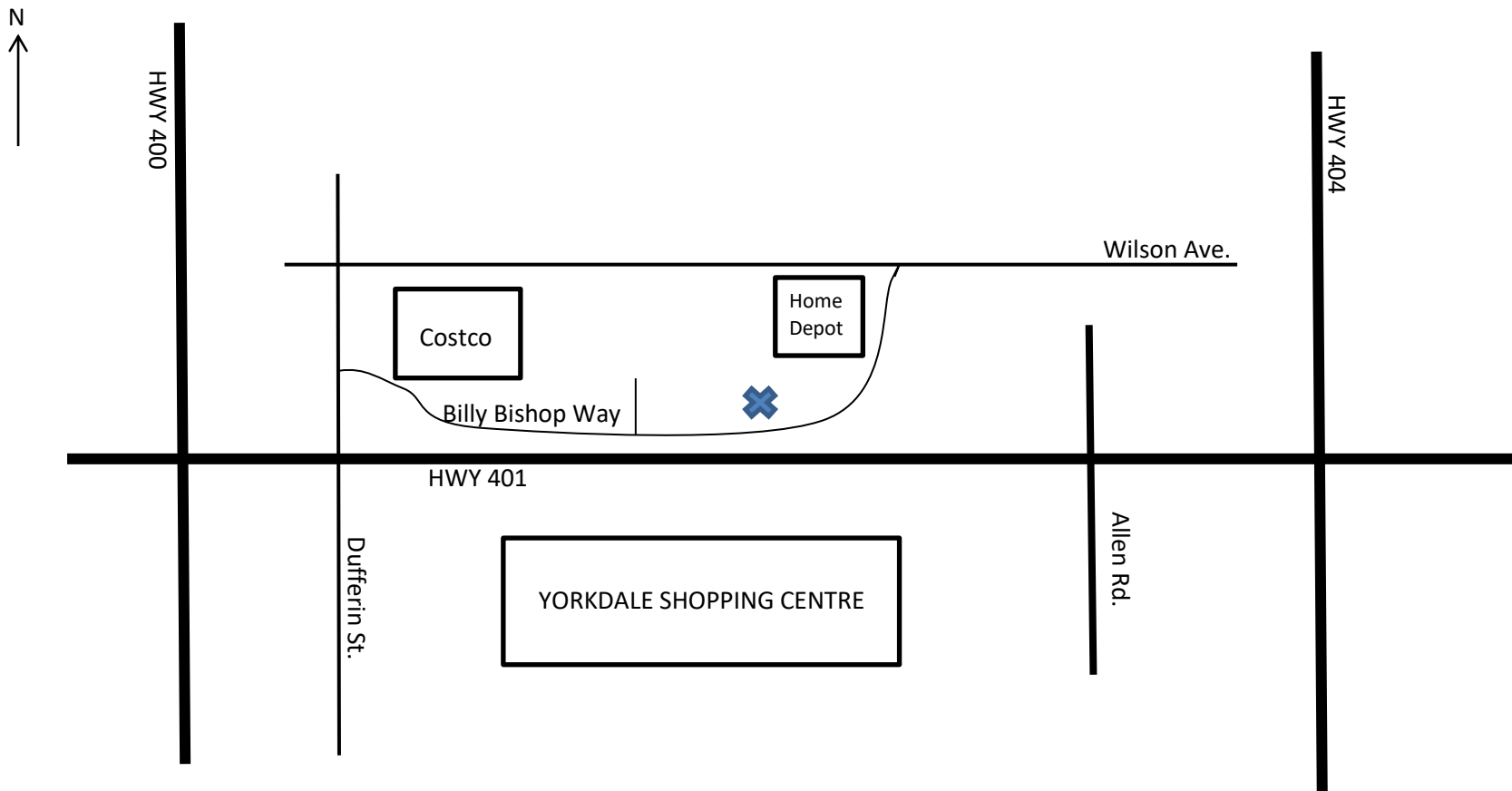
IMPORTANT TRAVEL INFORMATION

*Please give your son or daughter a box lunch if he or she is boarding the camp bus or van in the morning. If your child is coming part way by plane, please make reservations with an airline [Air Canada if possible] for the ticket now. Plan flights to Toronto to arrive before noon and flights from Toronto to depart after 1:30 pm. We will meet your child at the airport and also see her or him aboard the return plane. **PASSPORTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CAMPERS FLYING TO OR FROM CANADA. PASSPORTS ARE ALSO REQUIRED FOR LAND BORDER CROSSINGS INTO THE UNITED STATES.** Campers may only board or depart camp buses at the Toronto Airport if they are travelling by plane.*

DRIVING TO/FROM CAMP

NORTHWAY/WENDIGO is located inside Algonquin Park on Cache Lake [23 kms/15 miles from the west entrance to the Park, and 33kms/20 miles from the east entrance]. Access is by water from the Cache lake parking lot boat landing.
